

Geriatric Medicine CESR Checklist

This document has been created by the Geriatric Medicine SAC to assist CESR applicants in the collection of their evidence. Applicants can use this document to collect and order appropriate CESR evidence and can use it as a basis for efficiently and clearly compiled applications. Applicants are encouraged to use this document to collect their evidence, and to submit it with their final application to the GMC to have the best chance of success.

Important note: Applicants will have to follow the mandatory GMC application process and so should contact the GMC regarding their application before taking any further steps. While this document should support CESR applicants in the collection of their evidence, the GMC's application formatting will need to be followed, and evidence will need to be submitted in line with the GMC's application structure
